WHEREAS Mayor Sharp, municipal staff, the North Shore community of people with disabilities, and the local taxi industry are working together to address concerns regarding improvements in taxi service to people with disabilities on the North Shore;

WHEREAS municipal staffs and police services across the Lower Mainland are working on a plan to standardize taxi host requirements across the region; and

WHEREAS the current requirement for Taxi Host Level 2 in the “Cab Regulation Bylaw, 2004, No. 7621” puts the local industry at a competitive disadvantage;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT City Council request staff to relax enforcement of the Taxi Host Level 2 requirement in Bylaw No. 7621 until a regional standard is developed and as long as an agreement is in place between the North Shore Disability Resource Centre, Pam Horton and the North Shore taxi companies, that would ensure improved training for all North Shore Taxi Drivers in responding to and handling of clients with disabilities as set out by the North Shore Disability Resource Centre and North Shore Advisory Committee on Disability Issues.
